Amending the Standing Rules of the Senate to enable the participation of absent Senators during a national crisis.

Mr. PORTMAN (for himself, Mr. DURBIN, Ms. WARREN, Mr. SANDERS, Mr. KING, and Mr. SCHATZ) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

Amending the Standing Rules of the Senate to enable the participation of absent Senators during a national crisis.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. PARTICIPATION OF ABSENT SENATORS DUR-**
3 **ING A NATIONAL CRISIS.**

4 Rule XII of the Standing Rules of the Senate is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “5. Senators may use technology that has been
7 approved by the Secretary of the Senate and the
8 Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate as
9 reliable and secure to cast their votes from outside
10 of the Senate Chamber if the majority leader or his

1 or her designee and the minority leader or his or her
2 designee jointly determine that an extraordinary cri-
3 sis of national extent exists in which it would be in-
4 feasible for Senators to cast their votes in person. If
5 such a crisis is determined to exist, Senators may
6 cast votes under this paragraph during the 30-day
7 period beginning on the date on which such deter-
8 mination is made, unless such period is extended for
9 one or more additional 30-day periods by an affirm-
10 ative vote of three-fifths of the Senators duly chosen
11 and sworn. During such period, Senators partici-
12 pating remotely and using approved technology to
13 cast their votes under this paragraph shall be
14 deemed present for purposes of establishing the
15 presence of a quorum. The determination made
16 under this paragraph shall not rely on any decision
17 of any other branch of the United States Govern-
18 ment. The majority leader or his or her designee and
19 the minority leader or his or her designee shall sub-
20 mit at the beginning of the first session of each Con-
21 gress an order for designees of each caucus in the
22 case of such a crisis.”.
