CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center for a ceremony to present the Congressional Gold Medal collectively to the 23d Headquarters Special Troops and the 3133d Signal Services Company, known collectively as the “Ghost Army”, in recognition of unique and highly distinguished service during World War II.

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY**
4 **TO PRESENT CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL**

6 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
7 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on March
8 21, 2024, for a ceremony to present the Congressional

1 Gold Medal collectively to the 23d Headquarters Special
2 Troops and the 3133d Signal Services Company, known
3 collectively as the “Ghost Army”, in recognition of unique
4 and highly distinguished service during World War II.

5 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
6 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
7 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as the
8 Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
