## A BILL

To amend the Older Americans Act of 1965 to require reports to Congress on State Long-Term Care Ombudsman Programs, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Long-Term Care  
5       Transparency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING ON STATE LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDS-**  
2 **MAN PROGRAMS.**

3 Chapter 2 of subtitle A of title VII of the Older Amer-  
4 icans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3058f et seq.) is amended  
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 **“SEC. 714. REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**

7 “Each year, the Assistant Secretary shall submit, to  
8 the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pen-  
9 sions and the Special Committee on Aging of the Senate  
10 and the Committee on Education and the Workforce of  
11 the House of Representatives, a report that—

12 “(1) aggregates all reports submitted under sec-  
13 tion 712(h) for such year; and

14 “(2) provides a summary of the findings of  
15 such reports.”.
