## A BILL

To prohibit an entity from receiving Federal funds if such entity permits an individual to access or use a single-sex facility on the property of such entity that does not correspond to the biological sex of such person, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop the Invasion of  
5 Women’s Spaces Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
3 sion of law, no Federal funds may be provided, directly  
4 or indirectly, to an entity if such entity permits an indi-  
5 vidual to access or use a single-sex facility on the property  
6 of such entity that does not correspond to the biological  
7 sex of such person, except as provided by subsection (c).

8 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

9 (1) SINGLE-SEX FACILITY.—The term “single-  
10 sex facility” means a space intended for the use of  
11 one biological sex (male or female), including a—

12 (A) restroom;

13 (B) locker room; or

14 (C) changing room.

15 (2) PROPERTY.—The term “property” means  
16 any building, land, or other real property owned,  
17 leased, controlled, or occupied by an entity.

18 (3) BIOLOGICAL SEX.—The term “biological  
19 sex” means the biological determination as to wheth-  
20 er an individual is male or female, as such terms are  
21 defined in this section.

22 (4) FEMALE.—The term “female” means an in-  
23 dividual who naturally has, had, will have, or would  
24 have, but for a developmental or genetic anomaly or  
25 historical accident, the reproductive system that at

1       some point produces, transports, and utilizes eggs  
2       for fertilization.

3           (5) MALE.—The term “male” means an indi-  
4       vidual who naturally has, had, will have, or would  
5       have, but for a developmental or genetic anomaly or  
6       historical accident, the reproductive system that at  
7       some point produces, transports, and utilizes sperm  
8       for fertilization.

9           (6) ENTITY.—The term “entity” means any  
10      private entity, non-Federal Government agency or  
11      department, or State, tribal, or local government (in-  
12      cluding a political subdivision, department, or com-  
13      ponent thereof).

14      (c) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply with  
15      respect to an entity that permits an individual to access  
16      a single-sex facility on the property of such entity that  
17      does not correspond to the biological sex of such person  
18      in the circumstance of—

19           (1) emergency medical personnel responding to  
20      a medical emergency; or

21           (2) a law enforcement officer in active pursuit  
22      of a suspect, or as part of an active investigation.
