Mr. BURCHETT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to authorize the use of physical or digital copies of certain certificates for certain Federal Aviation Administration inspections, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pilot Certificate Acces-
5 sibility Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF CERTIFICATION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 44703 of title 49, United
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(m) SUFFICIENCY OF DIGITAL AND PHYSICAL COP-
6 IES OF AIRMAN CERTIFICATES.—An individual issued a
7 certificate pursuant to this section (including a medical
8 certificate) may present such certificate to an inspector
9 of the Federal Aviation Administration in any of the fol-
10 lowing formats:

11 “(1) A physical, original copy issued by the Ad-
12 ministrator (or his or her designee).

13 “(2) A digital copy stored on an electronic de-
14 vice or cloud storage platform, including a mobile
15 certificate issued by the Administrator.”.

16 (b) RULEMAKING.—The Administrator of the Fed-
17 eral Aviation Administration shall update regulations in
18 part 61 of title 14, Code of Federal Regulations, as nec-
19 essary, to implement the amendments made by this sec-
20 tion.

21 (c) APPLICABILITY.—Beginning on the date that is
22 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Admin-
23 istrator shall apply part 61, Code of Federal Regulations,
24 in a manner reflecting the changes to section 44703 of
25 title 49, United States Code, made by this Act.
