## A BILL

To extend preferential duty treatment program for Haiti under the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Hemispheric Oppor-  
5       tunity through Partnership Enhancement for Haitian  
6       Prosperity Act of 2024” or the “HOPE for Haitian Pros-  
7       perity Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PREFERENTIAL DUTY TREATMENT**  
2 **PROGRAM FOR HAITI.**

3 Section 213A of the Caribbean Basin Economic Re-  
4 covery Act (19 U.S.C. 2703a) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (b)—

6 (A) in paragraph (1)—

7 (i) in subparagraph (B)(v)(I)—

8 (I) by striking “means” and all  
9 that follows through “60 percent” and  
10 inserting “means 60 percent”; and

11 (II) by striking “7 succeeding 1-  
12 year periods” and inserting “12 suc-  
13 ceeding 1-year periods”; and

14 (ii) in subparagraph (C)—

15 (I) in the table, by striking “16  
16 succeeding 1-year periods” and insert-  
17 ing “23 succeeding 1-year periods”;  
18 and

19 (II) in the matter following the  
20 table, by striking “2025” and insert-  
21 ing “2030”; and

22 (B) in paragraph (2)—

23 (i) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by strik-  
24 ing “16 succeeding 1-year periods” and in-  
25 serting “21 succeeding 1-year periods”;  
26 and

1                   (ii) in subparagraph (B)(iii), by strik-  
2                   ing “16 succeeding 1-year periods” and in-  
3                   serting “21 succeeding 1-year periods”;  
4                   and  
5                   (2) in subsection (h), by striking “2025” and  
6                   inserting “2030”.
