- 6 (a) EVALUATION.—Not later than 90 days after the
- 7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agri-
- 8 culture and the Secretary of the Interior, in consultation
- 9 with the National Interagency Aviation Committee and the
- 10 Interagency Airtanker Board, shall jointly conduct an
- 11 evaluation of the container aerial firefighting system to as-
- 12 sess the use of such system to mitigate and suppress
- 13 wildfires.
- 14 (b) Report.—Not later than 120 days after the date
- 15 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture
- 16 and the Secretary of the Interior, in consultation with the
- 17 National Interagency Aviation Committee and the Inter-
- 18 agency Airtanker Board, shall jointly submit to the appro-
- 19 priate committees a report that includes the results of the
- 20 evaluation required under subsection (a).
- 21 (c) Appropriate Committees Defined.—In this
- 22 section, the term "appropriate committees" means—
- 23 (1) the Committees on Agriculture and Natural
- Resources of the House of Representatives; and

- 1 (2) the Committees on Agriculture, Nutrition,
- 2 and Forestry and Energy and Natural Resources of
