A BILL

To transfer the unobligated balances of amounts made available to the Internal Revenue Service under the Inflation Reduction Act to the Secretary of Homeland Security to secure the border.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “The Fund Our Border
5 Not The IRS Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNOBLIGATED BALANCES OF THE INTERNAL REV-**
2 **ENUE SERVICE MADE AVAILABLE TO SECURE**
3 **THE BORDER.**

4 The unobligated balances of all amounts made avail-
5 able to the Internal Revenue Service under Public Law
6 117–169 shall be transferred to the Secretary of Home-
7 land Security and be made available for the salaries and
8 expenses of agents and officers of U.S. Customs and Bor-
9 der Protection, constructing and maintaining physical bar-
10 riers along the southern international border of the United
11 States, and other purposes relating to border security.

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
