A BILL

To require an annual budget estimate for the initiatives of the National Institutes of Health pursuant to reports and recommendations made under the National Alzheimer's Project Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alzheimer’s Account-
5 ability and Investment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

7 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer’s Project Act (42
8 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-
10 section (i); and

11 (2) by inserting after subsection (g) the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(h) PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT BUDGET.—For fis-
14 cal year 2024 and each subsequent fiscal year, the Direc-
15 tor of the National Institutes of Health shall prepare and
16 submit, directly to the President for review and trans-
17 mittal to Congress, after reasonable opportunity for com-
18 ment, but without change, by the Secretary of Health and
19 Human Services and the Advisory Council, an annual
20 budget estimate for the initiatives of the National Insti-
21 tutes of Health pursuant to the reports and recommenda-
22 tions made under this Act, including an estimate of the
23 number and type of personnel needs for the National In-
24 stitutes of Health.”.

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
