A BILL

To amend the Energy Act of 2020 to require the Secretary of the Interior to include the Secretary of Health and Human Services in consultations regarding designations of critical minerals, elements, substances, and materials.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Recognizing the Impor-
5 tance of Critical Minerals in Healthcare Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIRED CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY**
7 **OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.**

8 Paragraphs (4)(C) and (5)(A) of section 7002(c) of
9 the Energy Act of 2020 (30 U.S.C. 1606(c)(4)(C) and
10 (5)(A)) are each amended by inserting “Health and
11 Human Services,” after “Agriculture,”.

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
