A BILL

To expand and modify the grant program of the Department of Veterans Affairs to provide innovative transportation options to veterans in highly rural areas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rural Veterans Trans-

5 portation to Care Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION AND MODIFICATION OF TRANSPOR-**
2 **TATION GRANT PROGRAM OF DEPARTMENT**
3 **OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

4 Section 307 of the Caregivers and Veterans Omnibus
5 Health Services Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–163; 38
6 U.S.C. 1710 note) is amended—

7 (1) in the section heading, by inserting
8 “**RURAL OR**” before “**HIGHLY**”;

9 (2) in subsection (a)—

10 (A) by inserting “rural or” before “highly”
11 each place it appears;

12 (B) in paragraph (2), by adding at the end
13 the following new subparagraph:

14 “(C) Tribal organizations.”;

15 (C) in paragraph (3), by striking “A State
16 veterans service agency or veterans service or-
17 ganization awarded” and inserting “A recipient
18 of”; and

19 (D) by striking paragraph (4) and insert-
20 ing the following new paragraph (4):

21 “(4) MAXIMUM AMOUNT.—

22 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in
23 subparagraph (B), the amount of a grant under
24 this section may not exceed \$60,000.

25 “(B) ADDITIONAL AMOUNT FOR ADA-COM-
26 PLIANT VEHICLE.—The amount of a grant

1 under this section to a recipient may be in-
2 creased to an amount not to exceed \$80,000 if
3 the recipient of such grant is required to pur-
4 chase a vehicle to comply with the requirements
5 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990
6 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.).”;

7 (3) in subsection (c)—

8 (A) by striking paragraph (1) and insert-
9 ing the following:

10 “(1) RURAL; HIGHLY RURAL.—The terms
11 ‘rural’ and ‘highly rural’ have the meanings given
12 such terms under the Rural-Urban Commuting
13 Areas (RUCA) coding system of the Department of
14 Agriculture.”;

15 (B) by redesignating paragraph (2) as
16 paragraph (3); and

17 (C) by inserting after paragraph (1), the
18 following new paragraph:

19 “(2) TRIBAL ORGANIZATION.—The term ‘trib-
20 al organization’ has the meaning given such term in
21 section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination and Edu-
22 cation Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304).”; and

1 (4) in subsection (d), by striking “\$3,000,000
2 for each of fiscal years 2010 through 2014” and in-
3 serting “such sums as may be necessary”.

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
