A BILL

To temporarily apply the E10 Reid vapor pressure limitations to E15 in the States of Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Ohio, South Dakota, and Wisconsin.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Year-Round E15 Act
5 of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. TEMPORARY APPLICABILITY OF E10 REID VAPOR**
7 **PRESSURE LIMITATIONS TO E15.**

8 During the period that begins on May 1, 2024, and
9 ends on September 15, 2024, in the States of Illinois,

1 Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Ohio, South Da-
2 kota, and Wisconsin, the Reid vapor pressure limitations
3 applicable to fuel blends containing gasoline and 15 per-
4 cent denatured anhydrous ethanol under subsections (f)
5 and (h) of section 211 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
6 7545) (including any waiver thereunder) shall be the same
7 as any such limitations applicable to fuel blends containing
8 gasoline and 10 percent denatured anhydrous ethanol
9 under such subsections.
