AN ACT

To require the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating certain land as the Lahaina National Heritage Area, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Lahaina National Her-
3 itage Area Study Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
7 the Secretary of the Interior.

8 (2) STATE.—The term “State” means the State
9 of Hawaii.

10 (3) STUDY AREA.—The term “study area”
11 means the census-designated place of Lahaina in
12 Maui County in the State.

13 **SEC. 3. LAHAINA NATIONAL HERITAGE AREA STUDY.**

14 The Secretary, in coordination with the County of
15 Maui and in consultation with State and local historic
16 preservation officers, State and local historical societies,
17 State and local tourism offices, and other appropriate or-
18 ganizations and governmental agencies, shall carry out, in
19 accordance with section 120103(a) of title 54, United
20 States Code, a study to assess the suitability and feasi-
21 bility of designating the study area as a National Heritage

1 Area, to be known as the “Lahaina National Heritage
2 Area”.
