A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Intelligence Rotational Assignment Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Ro-
5 tational Assignment Program and Law Enforcement Sup-
6 port Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY INTEL-**
8 **LIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**
9 **GRAM.**

10 Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
11 (6 U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
12 lowing new subsection:

13 “(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-
14 GRAM.—

15 “(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than one
16 year after the date of the enactment of this sub-
17 section, the Secretary shall establish an Intelligence
18 Rotational Assignment Program as part of the Rota-
19 tion Program under subsection (a).

20 “(2) ELIGIBILITY.—The Intelligence Rotational
21 Assignment Program shall be open to analysts serv-
22 ing in analyst positions in an intelligence component
23 of the Department, in the Office of Strategic Intel-
24 ligence and Information of the United States Secret

1 Service, or in other positions in the Department, as
2 determined by the Secretary.

3 “(3) COORDINATION.—The responsibilities
4 specified in subsection (a)(3)(B) that apply to the
5 Rotation Program under such subsection shall, as
6 applicable, apply to the Intelligence Rotational As-
7 signment Program under this subsection.”.
