Mrs. FISCHBACH, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6914) to require institutions of higher education to disseminate information on the rights of, and accommodations and resources for, pregnant students, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6918) to prohibit the Secretary of Health and Human Services from restricting funding for pregnancy centers; and providing

for consideration of the resolution (H.Res. 957) denouncing the Biden administration's open-borders policies, condemning the national security and public safety crisis along the southwest border, and urging President Biden to end his administration's open-borders policies.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 6914) to require institutions of higher education to dis-
4 seminate information on the rights of, and accommoda-
5 tions and resources for, pregnant students, and for other
6 purposes. All points of order against consideration of the
7 bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of a sub-
8 stitute recommended by the Committee on Education and
9 the Workforce now printed in the bill shall be considered
10 as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as
11 read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as
12 amended, are waived. The previous question shall be con-
13 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
14 further amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
15 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
16 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
17 member of the Committee on Education and the Work-
18 force or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to
19 recommit.

20 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
21 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 6918)

1 to prohibit the Secretary of Health and Human Services
2 from restricting funding for pregnancy centers. All points
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. In
4 lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
5 ommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now
6 printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of a sub-
7 stitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print
8 118–20 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as
9 amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order
10 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
11 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
12 bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto
13 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
14 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
15 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways
16 and Means or their respective designees; and (2) one mo-
17 tion to recommit.

18 SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
19 in order without intervention of any point of order to con-
20 sider in the House the resolution (H.Res. 957) denouncing
21 the Biden administration’s open-borders policies, con-
22 demning the national security and public safety crisis
23 along the southwest border, and urging President Biden
24 to end his administration’s open-borders policies. The res-
25 olution shall be considered as read. The previous question

1 shall be considered as ordered on the resolution and pre-
2 amble to adoption without intervening motion or demand
3 for division of the question except one hour of debate
4 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
5 minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary or
6 their respective designees.
