Mr. BURGESS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H.Res. 863) impeaching Alejandro Nicholas Mayorkas, Secretary of Homeland Security, for high crimes and misdemeanors, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 485) to amend title XI of the Social Security Act to prohibit the use of quality-adjusted life years and similar measures in coverage and payment determinations under Federal health care programs.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order without intervention of any point of order
3 to consider in the House the resolution (H.Res. 863) im-
4 peaching Alejandro Nicholas Mayorkas, Secretary of
5 Homeland Security, for high crimes and misdemeanors.
6 The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
7 ommended by the Committee on Homeland Security now
8 printed in the resolution shall be considered as adopted.
9 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
10 the resolution, as amended, to adoption without inter-
11 vening motion or demand for division of the question ex-
12 cept two hours of debate equally divided and controlled
13 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
14 mittee on Homeland Security or their respective designees.

15 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of House Resolution 863—

16 (a) House Resolution 995 is hereby adopted; and

17 (b) no other resolution incidental to impeachment re-
18 lating to House Resolution 863 shall be privileged during
19 the remainder of the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress.

20 SEC. 3. At any time after adoption of this resolution
21 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,
22 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the
23 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration
24 of the bill (H.R. 485) to amend title XI of the Social Secu-
25 rity Act to prohibit the use of quality-adjusted life years

1 and similar measures in coverage and payment determina-
2 tions under Federal health care programs. The first read-
3 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
4 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
5 bate shall be confined to the bill and amendments specified
6 in this section and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
7 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce or
9 their respective designees. After general debate the bill
10 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
11 rule. The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
12 ommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce
13 now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment print-
14 ed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
15 companying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted
16 in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The
17 bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original bill
18 for the purpose of further amendment under the five-
19 minute rule and shall be considered as read. All points
20 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
21 waived. No further amendment to the bill, as amended,
22 shall be in order except those printed in part B of the
23 report of the Committee on Rules. Each such further
24 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in
25 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated

1 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
2 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
3 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
4 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
5 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
6 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
7 such further amendments are waived. At the conclusion
8 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
9 shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House
10 with such further amendments as may have been adopted.
11 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
12 the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment
13 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
14 one motion to recommit.
