A BILL

To release the reversionary interest of the United States in certain non-Federal land in Salt Lake City, Utah, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “University of Utah
5 Research Park Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST OF THE**
2 **UNITED STATES IN NON-FEDERAL LAND IN**
3 **SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH.**

4 (a) RELEASE.—There is released to the University of
5 Utah, without consideration, the reversionary interest of
6 the United States in the non-Federal land described in
7 subsection (b).

8 (b) DESCRIPTION OF NON-FEDERAL LAND.—The
9 non-Federal land referred to in subsection (a) is the ap-
10 proximately 593 acres of land of the University of Utah—

11 (1) identified in the patent—

12 (A) numbered 43–99–0012; and

13 (B) dated October 18, 1968; and

14 (2) more particularly described as tracts D (ex-
15 cluding the parcels numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5), G,
16 and J, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., Salt Lake Meridian.
