A BILL

To amend the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 to clarify a provision relating to certain contents of registrations under that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Disclosing Foreign In-
3 fluence in Lobbying Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF CONTENTS OF REGISTRATION.**

5 Section 4(b) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995
6 (2 U.S.C. 1603(b)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “and” at the
8 end; and

9 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking “the offense.”
10 and inserting the following: “the offense; and

11 “(8) notwithstanding paragraph (4), the name
12 and address of each government of a foreign country
13 (including any agency or subdivision of a ~~foreign~~
14 ~~government~~ *government of a foreign country*, such as
15 a regional or municipal unit of government) and for-
16 eign political party, other than the client, that par-
17 ticipates in the direction, planning, supervision, or
18 control of any lobbying activities of the registrant.”.
