Whereas the young men and women who perished as a result
 of the bombing at Abbey Gate on August 26, 2021, rep-
 resent the best of the United States of America;

Whereas their service secured the blessings of liberty for the
 United States of America and the people of Afghanistan
 from those who sought to harm it;

Whereas their actions during the withdrawal of United States
 forces from Afghanistan saved the lives of thousands of
 innocents from the tyranny of the Taliban; and

Whereas their ultimate sacrifice on the 26th day of August
 2021 was not made in vain, and so long as their grateful
 Nation draws breath, their faithful service in the cause
 of liberty shall not be forgotten: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
 3 That the United States of America—

4 (1) designates a National Day of Remembrance
 5 in honor of the American servicemembers who made
 6 the ultimate sacrifice at the bombing of Abbey Gate
 7 at the Hamid Karzai International Airport in Kabul,
 8 Afghanistan, on August 26, 2021;

9 (2) expresses its deepest condolences and grati-
 10 tude to the Gold Star Families of those lost at
 11 Abbey Gate; and

- 1 (3) remembers their honorable and faithful
2 service to their Nation.
