JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require that certain individuals are natural born citizens.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*
6 *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*
7 *ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*
8 *States within seven years after the date of its submission*
9 *for ratification:*

1 “ARTICLE —
2 “Notwithstanding Article III of the Constitution, no
3 person who is not a natural born citizen may be a Judge,
4 either of the supreme or inferior courts. This section shall
5 take effect on the date that is six months following the
6 ratification of this article.”.

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
