## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed military sale to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4       Government of United Arab Emirates is prohibited:

5               (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6               and services described in Transmittal No. 24–118,  
7               submitted to Congress on May 13, 2025, pursuant  
8               to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act  
9               (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)): Six (6) CH–47F Block II

1 Chinook helicopters with air-to-air refuel probe capa-  
2 bility and extended range fuel tanks; Sixteen (16)  
3 T-55-GA-714A engines (12 installed, 4 spares);  
4 Fourteen (14) Embedded Global Positioning System  
5 (GPS)/Inertial Navigation System (INS) (EGI) de-  
6 vices with M-Code (12 installed, 2 spares); Eight  
7 (8) AN/AAR-57 Common Missile Warning Systems  
8 (CMWS) (6 installed, 2 spares); Twenty (20) AN/  
9 ARC-231A communications security (COMSEC) ra-  
10 dios (18 installed, 2 spares); Twenty (20) M-240  
11 machine guns (18 installed, 2 spares).
