A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Permanent CBDC Ban
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT PROHIBITION.**

2 Section 16A of the Federal Reserve Act is amended
3 by striking subsection (d) and redesignating subsection (e)
4 as subsection (d).

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
