Mrs. HINSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To establish a cancer research trust fund, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cancer Research Trust
5 Fund Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CANCER RESEARCH TRUST FUND.**

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the
8 Treasury a trust fund to be known as the “Cancer Re-
9 search Trust Fund” (referred to in this section as the
10 “Fund”) to be consisting of amounts appropriated as pro-
11 vided in this section.

1 (b) TRANSFERS TO FUND.—There are authorized to
2 be appropriated to the Fund amounts equal to ten percent
3 of the total amount collected in gross duties per fiscal year
4 on tobacco and tobacco substitute articles imported into
5 the United States.

6 (c) EXPENDITURES FROM FUND.—On request, the
7 Secretary of the Treasury shall transfer from the Fund
8 to the Secretary of Health and Human Services such
9 amounts necessary to carry out the purposes of the Fund.

10 (d) PURPOSES OF FUND.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
12 Human Services (in coordination with the Secretary
13 of War acting through the Director of the Defense
14 Health Agency) shall use amounts made available to
15 the Fund to carry out critical research and develop-
16 ment into early cancer screening prevention, treat-
17 ments, and innovative therapies.

18 (2) PRIORITIES.—In carrying out the purposes
19 under paragraph (1), the Secretary of Health and
20 Human Services shall prioritize rare cancers and
21 cancers affecting pediatric populations.

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
