A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to impose concurrence requirements prior to the adoption and enforcement of certain State emissions standards, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protect America from
5 CARB Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONCURRENCE REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN STATE**
7 **EMISSIONS STANDARDS.**

8 (a) CONCURRENCE REQUIRED.—Section 209 of the
9 Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7543) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)(1), by inserting “ and
2 after receiving concurrence from the Secretary of
3 Agriculture, the Secretary of Energy, the Secretary
4 of the Interior, and the Secretary of Transpor-
5 tation,” after “after notice and opportunity for pub-
6 lic hearing,”; and

7 (2) in subsection (e)(2)(A), by inserting “ and
8 after receiving concurrence from the Secretary of
9 Agriculture, the Secretary of Energy, the Secretary
10 of the Interior, and the Secretary of Transpor-
11 tation,” after “after notice and opportunity for pub-
12 lic hearing,”.

13 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
14 section (a) shall apply with respect to requests for waivers
15 or authorizations submitted on or after the date of enact-
16 ment of this Act.

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
