Mr. HAMADEH of Arizona introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to include certain prior active duty as a regular member of an Armed Force for reduced eligibility age for retirement as a member of the reserve components.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF CERTAIN PRIOR ACTIVE DUTY**
2 **AS A REGULAR MEMBER OF AN ARMED**
3 **FORCE FOR REDUCED ELIGIBILITY AGE FOR**
4 **RETIREMENT AS A MEMBER OF THE RE-**
5 **SERVE COMPONENTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 12731(f)(2) of title 10,
7 United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “as a
9 member of the Ready Reserve”; and

10 (2) in subparagraph (B), by adding at the end
11 the following new clause:

12 “(v) Service on active duty described in this subpara-
13 graph is also service on active duty as a regular member.”.

14 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.—The amend-
15 ments made by subsection (a) shall apply to qualifying
16 service on active duty performed after January 28, 2008.

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
