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## A BILL

To amend the Foreign Agents Registration Act to require social media influencers to submit registration statements, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Propaganda  
5       Disclosure Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF SOCIAL MEDIA INFLUENCERS.**

7       Section 1 of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of  
8       1938, as amended (22 U.S.C. 611) is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (h), by inserting “a social  
2       media influencer or” after “includes”;

3           (2) in subsection (p), by striking the period at  
4       the end and inserting a semicolon; and

5           (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
6       sections:

7       “(r) The term ‘social media influencer’ means any  
8       person who has a monetized social media account on any  
9       social media platform;

10       “(s) The term ‘social media platform’ has the mean-  
11       ing given such term defined in section 124 of the Traf-  
12       ficking Victims Prevention and Protection Reauthorization  
13       Act of 2022 (42 U.S.C. 1862w).”.

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
