Mr. KENNEDY of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred

A BILL

To require curbside delivery of mail at certain housing
developments, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIRING CURBSIDE DELIVERY OF MAIL AT**

4 **CERTAIN HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The United States Postal Serv-
6 ice—

7 (1) shall provide curbside delivery of mail to
8 residents of any housing development; and

9 (2) may not obligate or expend any funds (in-
10 cluding amounts within the Postal Service Fund

1 under section 2003 of title 39, United States Code)
2 to cease or otherwise limit curbside delivery at such
3 a development.

4 (b) HOUSING DEVELOPMENT DEFINED.—In this sec-
5 tion, the term “housing development” means a cluster of
6 50 or less single family homes in a subdivision, neighbor-
7 hood, or other similar grouping of residences, as deter-
8 mined by the Postal Service, that is located within 300
9 yards of any other residence that receives curbside deliv-
10 ery.

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
