A BILL

To provide for the continued use of certain trust land in
San Diego County for healthcare purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF TRUST LAND FOR HEALTHCARE PUR-**
4 **POSES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, the covered land may only be used for the
7 provision of health and social services for members of In-
8 dian Tribes.

9 (b) RESTRICTION ON USES.—The covered land shall
10 not be used for—

1 (1) class II gaming and class III gaming (as
2 those terms are defined in section 4 of the Indian
3 Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)); or

4 (2) any other commercial activities.

5 (c) TERMINATION.—The provisions of this Act shall
6 terminate on the date that is 50 years after the date of
7 enactment this Act.

8 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 (1) COVERED LAND.—The term “covered land”
10 means the approximately 8.6 acres of land in San
11 Diego County, California, described as Parcel No.
12 404–061–01, taken into trust by the United States
13 for the Ewiiapaayp Band of Kumeyaay Indians
14 (formerly referred to as the Cuyapaipe Band of Mis-
15 sion Indians) by grant deed dated February 26,
16 1986.

17 (2) INDIAN TRIBE.—The term “Indian Tribe”
18 has the meaning given such term in section 102 of
19 the Federally Recognized Indian Tribe List Act of
20 1994 (25 U.S.C. 5130).
