A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to disseminate to small business concerns certain information and resources relating to cybersecurity matters, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cybersecurity for
5 Small Businesses Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. INFORMATION AND RESOURCES RELATING TO CY-**
2 **BERSECURITY MATTERS FOR SMALL BUSI-**
3 **NESS CONCERNS.**

4 The Administrator of the Small Business Administra-
5 tion, in consultation with the Director of the Cybersecurity
6 and Infrastructure Security Agency, shall develop and dis-
7 seminate information and resources to assist small busi-
8 ness concerns in strengthening the cybersecurity infra-
9 structure of such concerns and implementing cybersecurity
10 best practices.

11 **SEC. 3. CYBERSECURITY COMPLIANCE INFORMATION.**

12 (a) **CYBERSECURITY COMPLIANCE RESOURCES.**—
13 The Administrator of the Small Business Administration,
14 in coordination with the Secretary of Defense and other
15 appropriate Federal agencies, shall disseminate informa-
16 tion to a small business concern seeking to enter into a
17 contract with the Federal Government, or seeking to be
18 a subcontractor on a Federal contract, regarding the Cy-
19 bersecurity Maturity Model Certification program (or suc-
20 cessor program), including information necessary to facili-
21 tate compliance with such requirements, through small
22 business development centers (as defined in section 3 of
23 the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632)) and district of-
24 fices of the Administration.

25 (b) **PUBLICATION.**—The Administrator shall include
26 the information described in subsection (a) in outreach

1 and communications of the Small Business Administra-
2 tion, including through publication on a website of the Ad-
3 ministration.

4 (c) BEST PRACTICES.—The Administrator shall an-
5 nually consult with the Chief Counsel for Advocacy of the
6 Office of Advocacy of the Administration to determine best
7 practices for the dissemination of other information relat-
8 ing to cybersecurity matters to small business concerns.

9 (d) ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after
10 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
11 after, the Chief Counsel for Advocacy shall submit to Con-
12 gress a report that includes the number and a description
13 of small business concerns that contacted the Chief Coun-
14 sel for Advocacy during the year covered by the report
15 with matters relating to cybersecurity of such concerns.

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
