5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal service located at 1706 South Burnside Avenue in

1 Gonzales, Louisiana, shall be designated as the “Cpl. Law-
2 rence Brown Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Cpl. Lawrence Brown
7 Post Office Building”.

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
