Ms. TITUS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal land for public purposes in Nevada to the Clark County Water Reclamation District.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Southern Nevada
5 Wastewater Infrastructure Lands Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) DISTRICT.—The term “District” means the
9 Clark County Water Reclamation District in Clark
10 County, Nevada.

1 (2) FEDERAL LAND.—The term “Federal land”
2 means approximately 257 acres of land managed by
3 the Bureau of Land Management and designated as
4 “Federal Land to be Conveyed” on the map pre-
5 pared by the Bureau of Land Management entitled
6 “Southern Nevada Wastewater Infrastructure Lands
7 Map” and dated May 19, 2026.

8 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
9 the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-
10 rector of the Bureau of Land Management.

11 **SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE TO THE CLARK COUNTY WATER REC-**
12 **LAMATION DISTRICT.**

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the land use
14 planning requirements of sections 202 and 203 of the Fed-
15 eral Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C.
16 1712, 1713), and subject to valid and existing rights, not
17 later than 180 days after receiving a request from the Dis-
18 trict, the Secretary shall convey to the District, without
19 consideration, all right, title, and interest of the United
20 States in and to the Federal land, to be used for public
21 purposes, including but not limited to the construction, op-
22 eration, and management of infrastructure operated by
23 the District to support the provision of critical wastewater
24 services.

1 (b) PAYMENT OF COSTS.—As a condition of the con-
2 veyance under subsection (a), the District shall pay all ad-
3 ministrative costs, including land surveys, associated with
4 the conveyance.

5 (c) MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable after
7 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
8 shall prepare maps and legal descriptions of the par-
9 cels of Federal land to be conveyed under subsection
10 (a).

11 (2) CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary may correct
12 any minor errors in the maps or legal descriptions
13 prepared under paragraph (1).

14 (3) AVAILABILITY.—The maps and legal de-
15 scriptions prepared under paragraph (1) shall be on
16 file and available for public inspection in the appro-
17 priate offices of the Bureau of Land Management.

18 (d) REVERSION.—If any parcel of Federal land con-
19 veyed under subsection (a) ceases to be used for public
20 purposes, the parcel of Federal land shall revert to the
21 United States.

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
