A BILL

To direct the Federal Trade Commission to revise the regulations regarding the “do-not-call” registry to prohibit politically-oriented recorded message telephone calls to telephone numbers listed on that registry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Robo Calls Off Phones
5 Act” or the “Robo COP Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. POLITICALLY-ORIENTED RECORDED MESSAGE**
2 **PHONE CALLS PROHIBITED.**

3 (a) PROHIBITED.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act and notwithstanding any
5 other provision of law, the Federal Trade Commission
6 shall revise the “do-not-call” registry provisions of the
7 Telemarketing Sales Rule (part 310 of title 16, Code of
8 Federal Regulations) to prohibit politically-oriented re-
9 corded message telephone calls to any telephone number
10 listed on that registry.

11 (b) POLITICALLY-ORIENTED RECORDED MESSAGE
12 CALLS DEFINED.—In this section, the term “politically-
13 oriented recorded message telephone call” means any out-
14 bound telephone call—

15 (1) in which a person is not available to speak
16 with the person answering the call, and the call in-
17 stead plays a recorded message; and

18 (2) the—

19 (A) purpose of which is to promote, adver-
20 tise, campaign, or solicit donations, for or
21 against any political candidate or regarding any
22 political issue; or

23 (B) recorded message includes the name of
24 a political candidate.

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
