A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to require the disclosure of return information to the Small Business Administration for the purposes of carrying out the Disaster Loan Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fast Track Disaster
5 Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF RETURN INFORMATION TO SMALL**
2 **BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION FOR PURPOSES**
3 **OF CARRYING OUT DISASTER LOAN PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6103(l) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
7 the following new paragraph:

8 “(23) DISCLOSURE OF RETURN INFORMATION
9 TO SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION FOR PUR-
10 POSES OF CARRYING OUT DISASTER LOAN PRO-
11 GRAM.—

12 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall,
13 upon written request from the Administrator of
14 the Small Business Administration, disclose to
15 officers and employees of the Small Business
16 Administration return information of a tax-
17 payer who is an applicant for a loan under sec-
18 tion 7(b) of the Small Business Act.

19 “(B) RESTRICTION ON DISCLOSURE.—Re-
20 turn information disclosed under subparagraph
21 (A) may be used by officers and employees of
22 the Small Business Administration only for the
23 purposes of, and to the extent necessary in, de-
24 termining a taxpayer’s eligibility for a loan
25 under section 7(b) of the Small Business Act.”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section
2 6103(p)(4) of such Code is amended in the matter pre-
3 ceding subparagraph (A) and in subparagraph (F)(ii), by
4 striking “or (22),” and inserting “(22), or (23),” each
5 place it appears.

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to disclosures made after the date
8 of the enactment of this Act.

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
