A BILL

To assist survivors of stroke and other debilitating health
occurrences in returning to work.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Return to Employment
5 Through Understanding and Recovery Navigation Act” or
6 “RETURN Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ASSISTING SURVIVORS OF STROKE AND OTHER DE-**
2 **BILITATING HEALTH OCCURRENCES IN RE-**
3 **TURNING TO WORK.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Labor, acting
5 through the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Disability
6 Employment Policy and in coordination with the Secretary
7 of Health and Human Services, may disseminate informa-
8 tion and promote awareness among survivors of stroke and
9 other health conditions, such as traumatic brain injury
10 and heart attack, and the families of such survivors, as
11 well as among private employers, government agencies,
12 employee representatives, and service providers to—

13 (1) assist survivors of stroke and such other
14 health conditions in returning to work;

15 (2) improve access to reasonable accommoda-
16 tions for employees who are survivors;

17 (3) to assist employers in providing workplaces
18 with such accommodations to such employees; and

19 (4) enhance self-employment and entrepreneur-
20 ship options for survivors.

21 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
22 of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Sec-
23 retary of Labor shall submit to Congress a report on any
24 actions taken pursuant to subsection (a).

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
