3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Priority for Pediatric
5 Cures Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO AWARD**
2 **PRIORITY REVIEW VOUCHERS FOR RARE PE-**
3 **DIATRIC DISEASE PRODUCTS.**
