A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DETECTIVE ALLAN REDDINS POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 901 Lake Street in Oak Park,
7 Illinois, shall be known and designated as the “Detective
8 Allan Reddins Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Detective Allan
5 Reddins Post Office Building”.
