3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF JUNIOR DUCK STAMP**
4 **CONSERVATION AND DESIGN PROGRAM ACT**
5 **OF 1994.**

6 (a) *DEFINITION OF STATE.*—Section 5 of the Junior
7 *Duck Stamp Conservation and Design Program Act of 1994*
8 *(16 U.S.C. 719b–1) is amended—*

9 (1) *by inserting “and” after “Guam,”; and*
10 (2) *by striking “, and any other territory or pos-*
11 *session” after “Virgin Islands”.*

12 (b) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.*—Section 6
13 *of the Junior Duck Stamp Conservation and Design Pro-*
14 *gram Act of 1994 (16 U.S.C. 719c) is amended in subsection*
15 *(a) by striking “2006 through 2010” and inserting “2025*
16 *through 2031”.*
