Ms. HAGEMAN (for herself and Mrs. MILLER of Illinois) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Workforce

A BILL

To amend the General Education Provisions Act to require parental notification and consent with respect to certain activities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Parental Oversight and
5 Educational Transparency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF PUPIL RIGHTS.**

7 Section 445(c)(2)(B) of the General Education Provi-
8 sions Act (20 U.S.C. 1232h) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “The local educational agency”
2 and inserting the following:

3 “(i) IN GENERAL.—The local edu-
4 cational agency”; and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(ii) WRITTEN CONSENT RE-
7 QUIRED.—In addition to the notification
8 required under clause (i), not later than 14
9 days before the specific date during the
10 school year on which an activity described
11 in subparagraph (C) will occur, the local
12 educational agency shall directly notify the
13 parent of a student of such date and re-
14 ceive written consent from such parent in
15 order for such student to participate in
16 such activity.”.

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
