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## AN ACT

To amend the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act to  
require reporting regarding clean energy demonstration  
projects, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Clean Energy Dem-  
3 onstration Transparency Act of 2025”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND OVERSIGHT REPORT-**  
5 **ING REQUIREMENTS.**

6       Subsection (h) of section 41201 of the Infrastructure  
7 Investment and Jobs Act (42 U.S.C. 18861) is amended  
8 by adding at the end following new paragraph:

9           “(3) FURTHER REPORTS.—

10           “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than six  
11 months after the date of the enactment of this  
12 paragraph and at least semiannually thereafter,  
13 the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on  
14 Science, Space, and Technology and the Com-  
15 mittee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-  
16 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and  
17 Natural Resources and the Committee on Ap-  
18 propriations of the Senate a report, and make  
19 publicly available in digital online format, that  
20 contains, for the period covered by each such  
21 report, for each covered project or other dem-  
22 onstration project administered or supported by  
23 the program, the following:

24           “(i) A copy of any initial contracts or  
25 financial assistance agreements executed  
26 between the Department and an award re-

1            cipient, including any related documenta-  
2            tion, as the Secretary determines appro-  
3            priate.

4            “(ii) A list of any material, technical,  
5            or financial milestones that have or have  
6            not been met.

7            “(iii) Any material modifications to  
8            the scope, schedule, funding profile (in-  
9            cluding cost-share requirements), project  
10           partners or participating entities, or budg-  
11           et of the project.

12           “(B) STREAMLINING.—To the extent prac-  
13           ticable, the Secretary may synchronize the re-  
14           ports required under subparagraph (A) with  
15           other required reports, such as those required  
16           under—

17           “(i) paragraph (1); and

18           “(ii) section 9005(e) of the Energy  
19           Act of 2020 (42 U.S.C. 7256c(e); enacted

1 as division Z of the Consolidated Appro-  
2 priations Act, 2021).”.
