A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EQUALIZING THE NEGOTIATION PERIOD BE-**
2 **TWEEN SMALL-MOLECULE AND BIOLOGIC**
3 **CANDIDATES UNDER THE DRUG PRICE NEGO-**
4 **TIATION PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1192(e)(1)(A)(ii) of the
6 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320f–1(e)(1)(A)(ii)) is
7 amended by striking “7 years” and inserting “11 years”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
10 ment of Public Law 117–169.
