A BILL

To terminate the Shelter and Services Program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End FEMA Benefits
5 for Illegal Immigrants Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION.**

2 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Administrator of the Federal
3 Emergency Management Agency may not carry out any
4 program to support sheltering and related activities pro-
5 vided by non-Federal entities, including facility improve-
6 ments and construction, in support of relieving over-
7 crowding in short-term holding facilities of U.S. Customs
8 and Border Protection.

9 (b) RESCISSION.—The unobligated balances of the
10 following amounts are rescinded:

11 (1) The amounts made available and trans-
12 ferred to the Federal Emergency Management Agen-
13 cy in the matter under the heading “OPERATIONS
14 AND SUPPORT” under the heading “U.S. CUSTOMS
15 AND BORDER PROTECTION” under the heading

19 117–328; 136 Stat. 4730).
