A BILL

To redesignate the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center in Casper, Wyoming, as the “Barbara L. Cubin National Historic Trails Interpretive Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF BARBARA L. CUBIN NA-**
4 **TIONAL HISTORIC TRAILS INTERPRETIVE**
5 **CENTER.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The National Historic Trails In-
7 terpretive Center established under section 2(a) of Public
8 Law 105–290 (112 Stat. 2783) in Casper, Wyoming, shall
9 be known and designated as the “Barbara L. Cubin Na-
10 tional Historic Trails Interpretive Center”.

11 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
12 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
13 States to the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center
14 referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a ref-
15 erence to the “Barbara L. Cubin National Historic Trails
16 Interpretive Center”.

17 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 2(a) of
18 Public Law 105–290 (112 Stat. 2783) is amended, in the
19 second sentence, by striking “the National Historic Trails
20 Interpretive Center” and inserting “the ‘Barbara L. Cubin
21 National Historic Trails Interpretive Center’ ”.

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
