Mr. OGLES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To prohibit any transactions using Alipay in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Alipay Act of
5 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF ALIPAY.**

7 No financial transactions between AliPay (China)
8 Internet Technology Company Limited (referred to in this
9 Act as “AliPay”) and a United States person are per-
10 mitted, including the use of any application or payment
11 processing services operated by Alipay.

1 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

2 In this Act:

3 (1) The term “United States person” means—

4 (A) a national of the United States;

5 (B) an alien lawfully admitted for perma-
6 nent residence;

7 (C) an entity organized under the laws of
8 the United States or under the laws of any ju-
9 risdiction within the United States (including a
10 foreign branch of such an entity); or

11 (D) an individual who is physically present
12 in the United States.

13 (2) The term “financial transaction” means—

14 (A) a transaction which in any way or de-
15 gree affects interstate or foreign commerce—

16 (i) involving the movement of funds
17 by wire or other means; or

18 (ii) involving one or more monetary
19 instruments; or

20 (B) a transaction involving the use of a fi-
21 nancial institution which is engaged in, or the
22 activities of which affect, interstate or foreign
23 commerce in any way or degree.

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
