A BILL

To repeal the Alien Registration Act of 1940.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Round Up Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF ALIEN REGISTRATION ACT OF 1940.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 7 of title II of the Immi-
7 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1301 et seq.) is
8 amended—

9 (1) by repealing section 262;

1 (2) in section 263—

2 (A) in subsection (a)—

3 (i) by striking “the provisions of sec-
4 tions 261 and 262” and inserting “section
5 261”;

6 (ii) by inserting “and” after “alien
7 crewmen,”; and

8 (iii) by striking “, (3) aliens confined
9 in institutions” and all that follows and in-
10 serting a period; and

11 (B) by repealing subsection (b);

12 (3) in section 264—

13 (A) in subsection (a), by striking “, and
14 the Attorney General is authorized and directed
15 to prepare forms for the registration and
16 fingerprinting of aliens under section 262 of
17 this title”; and

18 (B) by repealing subsection (e);

19 (4) by repealing subsection (b) of section 265;

20 and

21 (5) by repealing section 266.

22 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Clause (i) of sec-
23 tion 237(a)(3)(B) of the Immigration and Nationality Act
24 (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(3)(B)) is repealed.

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
