# **A BILL**

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Intelligence Rotational Assignment Program, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       *This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Rota-*  
5       *tional Assignment Program and Law Enforcement Support*  
6       *Act”.*

7       **SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY INTEL-**  
8                       **LIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**  
9                       **GRAM.**

10       *Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6*  
11       *U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the following*  
12       *new subsection:*

13       “(b) *OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL INTEL-*  
14       *LIGENCE (ODNI) INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY CIVILIAN*  
15       *JOINT DUTY PROGRAM.—The Secretary shall require all*  
16       *components of the Department that are members of the*  
17       *DHS Intelligence Enterprise to participate in the ODNI*  
18       *Intelligence Community Civilian Joint Duty Program in*  
19       *a manner consistent with the policies established by the Di-*  
20       *rector of National Intelligence for the Program.”.*
