## A BILL

To nullify the final rule of the Environmental Protection Agency titled “Reconsideration of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards for Particulate Matter”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Common Sense Air  
5       Regulations Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NULLIFICATION OF FINAL RULE RELATING TO RE-**  
2 **CONSIDERATION OF THE NATIONAL AMBIENT**  
3 **AIR QUALITY STANDARDS FOR PARTICULATE**  
4 **MATTER.**

5 The final rule of the Environmental Protection Agen-  
6 cy titled “Reconsideration of the National Ambient Air  
7 Quality Standards for Particulate Matter” (89 Fed. Reg.  
8 16202 (March 6, 2024)) shall have no force or effect.
