3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wetlands Conservation
5 and Access Improvement Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF INTEREST ON OBLIGATIONS**
7 **HELD IN FEDERAL AID TO WILDLIFE RES-**
8 **TORATION FUND.**

9 Section 3(b)(2)(C) of the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife
10 Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 669b(b)(2)(C)) is amended by
11 striking “2026” and inserting “2033”.
