AN ACT

To take certain Federal land in the State of California into trust for the benefit of the Pit River Tribe.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Pit River Land Trans-
- 3 fer Act of 2025".
- 4 SEC. 2. LAND TO BE TAKEN INTO TRUST.
- 5 (a) Transfer of Four Corners Federal
- 6 Land.—
- 7 (1) In general.—Subject to valid existing
- 8 rights, the Four Corners Federal land is hereby
- 9 taken into trust by the Secretary for the benefit of
- the Tribe.
- 11 (2) Survey.—Not later than 180 days after
- the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
- 13 Agriculture shall provide to the Secretary a complete
- survey of the Four Corners Federal land.
- 15 (b) Administration.—Upon being taken into trust
- 16 under this section, the lands taken into trust by the Sec-
- 17 retary for the benefit of the Tribe shall be—
- 18 (1) considered part of the Pit River Tribe Res-
- 19 ervation; and
- 20 (2) administered by the Secretary in accordance
- 21 with the laws and regulations generally applicable to
- property held in trust by the United States for an
- 23 Indian Tribe.
- (c) Gaming Prohibited.—Land taken into trust
- 25 under this section shall not be used for any class II gam-
- 26 ing or class III gaming under the Indian Gaming Regu-

1	latory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) (as those terms are
2	defined in section 4 of that Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)).
3	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:
4	(1) Four corners federal land.—
5	(A) In general.—The term "Four Cor-
6	ners Federal land" means the approximately
7	583.79 acres of land managed by the Forest
8	Service generally depicted within the "Proposed
9	Land Conveyance" boundary on the Map, in-
10	cluding improvements and appurtenances there-
11	on.
12	(B) Exclusion.—The term "Four Cor-
13	ners Federal land" does not include the ap-
14	proximately 20.03 acres of roads, highways,
15	and public rights-of-way subject to existing
16	easements generally depicted within the "Pro-
17	posed Land Conveyance" boundary on the Map.
18	(2) Map.—The term "Map" means the map ti-
19	tled "Proposed Land Conveyance to the Pit River
20	Tribe" prepared by the Forest Service and dated
21	November 6, 2024.
22	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
23	the Secretary of the Interior.
24	(4) Tribe.—The term "Tribe" means the Pit
25	River Tribe, California (includes XL Ranch, Big

- 1 Bend, Likely, Lookout, Montgomery Creek, and
- 2 Roaring Creek Rancherias).
