A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the communication of classified information on mobile or desktop messaging application, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeland Operations
5 and Unilateral Tactics Halting Incursions: Preventing Co-
6 ordinated Subversion, Military Aggression and Lawless
7 Levies Granting Rogue Operatives Unchecked Power Act
8 of 2025” or the “HOUTHI PC SMALL GROUP Act of
9 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMMUNICATION OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATION ON**
2 **MOBILE OR DESKTOP MESSAGING APPLICA-**
3 **TION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 37 of title 18, United
5 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 798A
6 the following:

7 **“§ 798B. Communication of classified information on**
8 **mobile or desktop messaging application**

9 “Whoever knowingly communicates, furnishes, trans-
10 mits, or otherwise makes available any classified informa-
11 tion on a mobile or desktop messaging application shall
12 be fined under this title, imprisoned not more than 10
13 years, or both.”.

14 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
15 for chapter 37 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
16 by inserting after the item related to section 798A the fol-
17 lowing:

“798B. Communication of classified information on mobile or desktop messaging
application.”.
