To confirm the use of certain non-Federal land in Salt Lake City, Utah, for public purposes, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "University of Utah
- 3 Research Park Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. CONFIRMATION OF USE OF CERTAIN NON-FEDERAL
- 5 LAND IN SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH, FOR VALID
- 6 PUBLIC PURPOSES.
- 7 (a) Confirmation of Uses.—
- 8 (1) In General.—The use by the University of 9 Utah of the land described in subsection (b) as a 10 University research park, as approved by the letter 11 from the Secretary of the Interior to the University 12 of Utah dated December 10, 1970, and any modi-13 fications of the approved plan of development and 14 management approved by the Department of the In-15 terior prior to the date of enactment of this Act, is 16 confirmed as a valid public purpose consistent with 17 the requirements of the Act of June 14, 1926 (com-18 monly known as the "Recreation and Public Pur-19 poses Act") (44 Stat. 741, chapter 578; 43 U.S.C. 20 869 et seq.), subject to the terms and conditions in-

cluded in the letter and approvals.

(2) Other uses.—Any other uses of the land described in subsection (b) by the University of Utah that are consistent with use as a University research park and related university purposes (including development of student housing and a transit hub) are

- 14 bered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5), G, and J, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., Salt
- 15 Lake Meridian.
